



NEW SKINNING TOWER SAVES PHYSICAL POWER OF EMPLOYEES AND MAKES THEM TO STAY

New Jasopels Skinning Tower Automatic guarantees easier and far less physical work during the season

It was elderly workers who were the main reason for Henning Henriksen to invest in the new Jasopels Skinning Tower Automatic in the previous season.

– Workers who help me in a fur season are, like me, around 50 years old. So if I wanted them to skin for another five years, there was a need for relief.

– The old skinning tower was physically demanding, whereas the new model can even take the skins directly without pulling the skin first, which makes work far less exhausting, he says.

Henning Henriksen had previously invested in the Jasopels Skinning Machine T11, which he was very pleased with.

– It is a machine I indeed have been very happy with, but the new model hits the bull's eye because it is not so demanding, he concludes.



It is also worth mentioning that the machine fits in the pelting center very well thanks to its dimensions.

– The machine is quite compact which I see as an advantage. It means that we can keep the whole pelting in one place so we don't need to go very far from one task to another, says Henning Henriksen.

The new skinning tower means also a change to an electric system.

– It is very important because now we can control the process much better due to much more dynamic pull of animals and skins, emphasizes Henning Henriksen.

Evening work throughout the season

Henning Henriksen has 2.400 females and pelted 13.000 minks in the previous season. From this point of view he sees Jasopels Skinning Tower Automatic as the right choice.

– It is also very interesting in terms of price. Taking into consideration the number of animals we need to skin, the machine fits in well. We are actually considering buying one more tower, says Henrik Henriksen.

Unlike many other farmers, Henning and his employees work in the evenings.

– Our workers come after their regular working hours and we must have 6-700 skins ready, therefore we are little pressed for time. We try to keep Sundays free. On Saturdays we work from 7 to 15 and get 1.200 skins through, explains Henning Henriksen.

He admits that it might be slightly more expensive to work this way.

– It is nice that I can get help from the same people and don't need to search new ones every year.

– Thanks to their great experience, my workers can repair and service the machines themselves. They take the initiative, without asking first. It is a huge advantage, emphasizes Henning Henriksen.
